

Electricity delivery pricing - supplementary schedule

(applicable from 1 November 2026)



This supplementary schedule sets out additional prices introduced by Orion for the Halswell Flex pilot. Participation in the Halswell Flex Residential price category is voluntary and is limited to eligible connections.

The prices in this schedule are an alternative to the standard prices set out in Orion's main Price Schedule, which otherwise remains unchanged.

These are wholesale delivery prices that Orion applies when charging electricity retailers and directly connected customers for the conveyance of electricity across Orion's network. Delivery charges relate to the transmission and distribution of electricity to homes and businesses and do not include the cost of electricity itself. Customers should contact their electricity retailer for information on retail electricity pricing and the charges that apply to their account.

Notes

1. Eligibility is limited to:

- retailers that have met Orion's requirements to become Halswell Flex Participating Retailers, and
- connections in Orion's defined Halswell Flex pilot area (a schedule is available on request), and
- connections in the residential pricing categories URES, RES, RSU, RSC, and
- available for entry from 1 November 2026 until 30 April 2029 (unless the trial is extended).

2. The peak event price and peak event export credit are only applied May through August, and are based on average demand or export during signalled peak periods within the applicable month.

4. The applicable price category is recorded against each connection ICP on the Electricity Authority's registry, and the price component is used in our mandatory 'electricity information exchange protocol' files.
